



General Terms and Conditions

B. Babywearing AB is further referred to as the Organizer.

The company registered to participate in the Festival is further referred to as the Exhibitor.

1. The registration to participate as an exhibitor is binding.
2. The entries are registered in the order they are received by the Organizer. An exhibition stand at the Festival cannot be made available after the Festival has been fully booked. Exhibition stands are assigned according to the following principle:
 - The registration must have been received before the deadline for registrations. Those who have submitted the registration after this date will be allocated to a vacant area, subject to availability.
 - If the Exhibitor requests a certain exhibition stand, the Organizer will do its best to ensure that the request is met, but the Organizer has the right to make adjustments until the day of the Festival.
3. Exhibitor will receive an invoice as soon as possible after registration, and the invoice must be paid in full within 30 days, or as agreed, but no later than before the opening of the Festival. If not paid in full, the Organizer is entitled to restrict the exhibition stand and associated equipment if required.
4. Cancellation of participation must be made in writing. Cancellations are accepted up until the invoice is due for payment. However, cancellations are not accepted after the deadline for registration, even if the deadline occurs earlier than the due date of the invoice.
5. Exhibited goods must be in accordance with government authorities and / or the regulatory body's regulations and shall, where necessary, be provided with approval from the relevant authorities or bodies. The Organizer disclaims all liability for damages or obligations as a result of non-compliance or that an approval has not been obtained. If this occurs, the Exhibitor shall replace the Organizer for all costs.
6. Advertising devices, signs and other exhibition objects shall be in the exhibition stand. Devices that are outside the exhibition stand must be moved on request of the Organizer or may be moved away by the Organizer if the request is not complied with.
7. Exhibitor is, without the Organizer's permission, not allowed to
 - place objects outside the exhibition stand or block fire protection devices, fire doors or power stations.
 - arranging the exhibition stand, decorations, demonstrations and sales in ways that disturb other exhibitors and visitors.
8. Exhibitor is obliged to submit to the adjustments in place and space that may be needed due to unforeseen circumstances.
9. Exhibitors do not have the right to play music in exhibition stands or have other activities that interfere with surrounding exhibitors.
10. Exhibitor must not cause damage to the building. Nailing, painting, taping, etc. is not allowed.

11. The Exhibitor must have insurance covering damage on the Exhibitor's own goods and staff. The exception is the equipment that the Organizer rents out in the package that the Exhibitor purchased from the Organizer. For damage to person or building or other property, which is caused by the Exhibitor or its staff, the Exhibitor is liable for compensation.
12. The exhibition stand must be unpacked and completed by the Exhibitor before the time of the opening of the Festival. Packing or dismantling of the exhibition stand must not be started before the Festival ends and is closed.
13. Exhibitor is obliged to comply with the guidelines of the Festival management and any safety regulations that authorities may issue
14. In the event of a violation of these general terms and conditions, the Exhibitor and staff may be rejected from the exhibition area. The Exhibitor is not entitled, in view of this, to raise demands on the Organizer for a refund of fees or for damages.
15. Information about the Exhibitor is published in the digital exhibition map.
16. Exhibitor undertake to provide the Organizer with the Exhibitor's logotype, information about the Exhibitor, product images etc. for marketing via channels that the Organizer decides.
17. Exhibitor gives the Organizer right of disposition to photos, material, files etc. provided to the Organizer for this purpose.
18. Exhibitor undertake to ensure that goods and materials arrive in time for the Festival and will be picked up after the Festival according to the given instructions.
19. The Organizer reserves the right to film, photograph and record sound during the Festival and has the right to use the material now and in the future. The Organizer owns the rights to the material and reserves the right to edit the material if necessary.
